

Level 2 Award for CCTV Operators (Public Space Surveillance) in the Private Security Industry – 3 Days

Course Overview

Any business that uses CCTV to monitor a public space or members of the public will need trained security staff qualified as a CCTV operator and who hold a SIA licence. A level 2 award for working as a CCTV operator within the private security industry qualification is required by law for an individual to apply for a SIA licence to work as a CCTV operator.

Course Contents

- Understand how to use CCTV equipment.
- Be able to operate the CCTV system.
